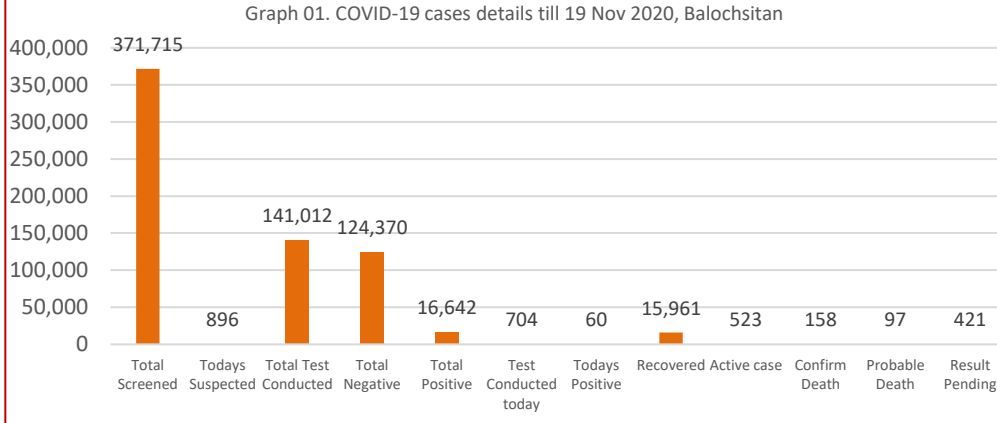

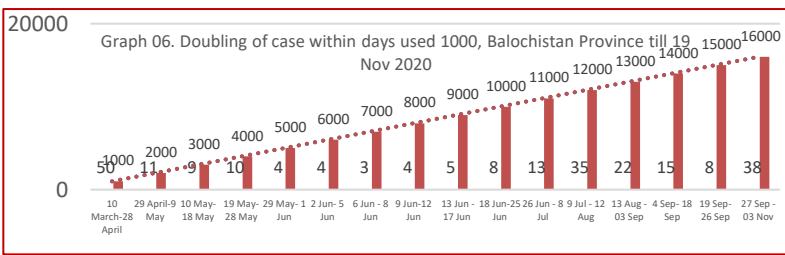
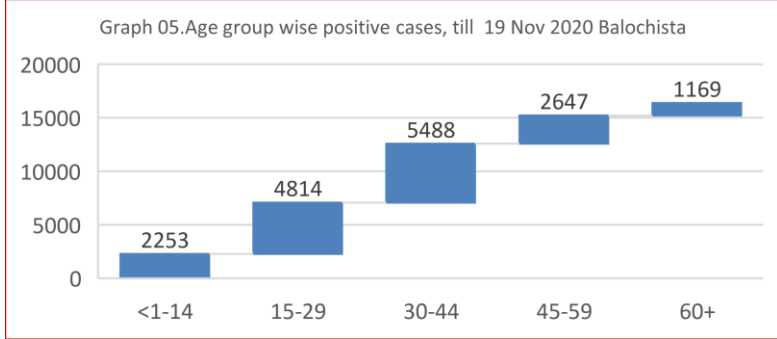
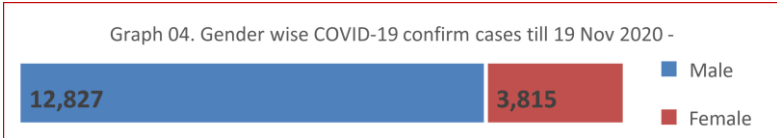
COVID-19 Cases / Deaths BALUCHISTAN



Districts with Local transmissions & imported cases from other provinces



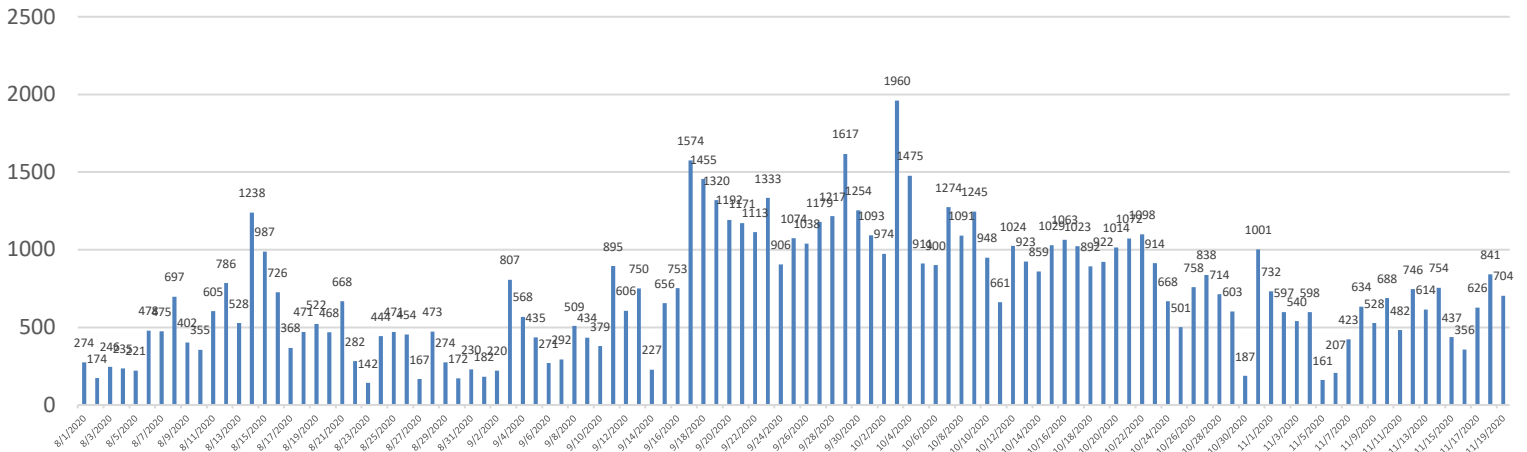
- In last 24 hours 281 COVID-19 tests conducted in education institutes, 14 came positive, Cumulative 17,258 lab tests conducted, 891 came positive. 0 results awaited, and Positively rate is 5.2% (Graph 13).
- In last 24 hours 60 confirmed COVID-19 cases have been reported from 07 districts and including 01 death, total has climbed to 16,642. The active cases are 523 and overall confirmed deaths 158 (CFR 1%).
- Out of 16,642, 99% (16,507) cases are from local community, Quetta (11,866) followed by Kech (581), Jaffarabad (415), Khuzdar (422), Lasbela (365) and Mastung (292). (Table 01).
- Latest update: 21 patients admitted in province and 17 patients in high flow oxygen and 04 in low flow oxygen. No one on vent.
- In last 24 hours 19 asymptomatic home isolated COVID-19 Positive persons recovered/released after completion of 13 days' isolation with clear guidelines to follow all SOPs. The total recovered are 15,961 which is 96% of total cases.
- The District Rapid Response Team – Quetta (RRT) screened 2,751 individuals and took 896 Samples of Suspect for further lab diagnosis.



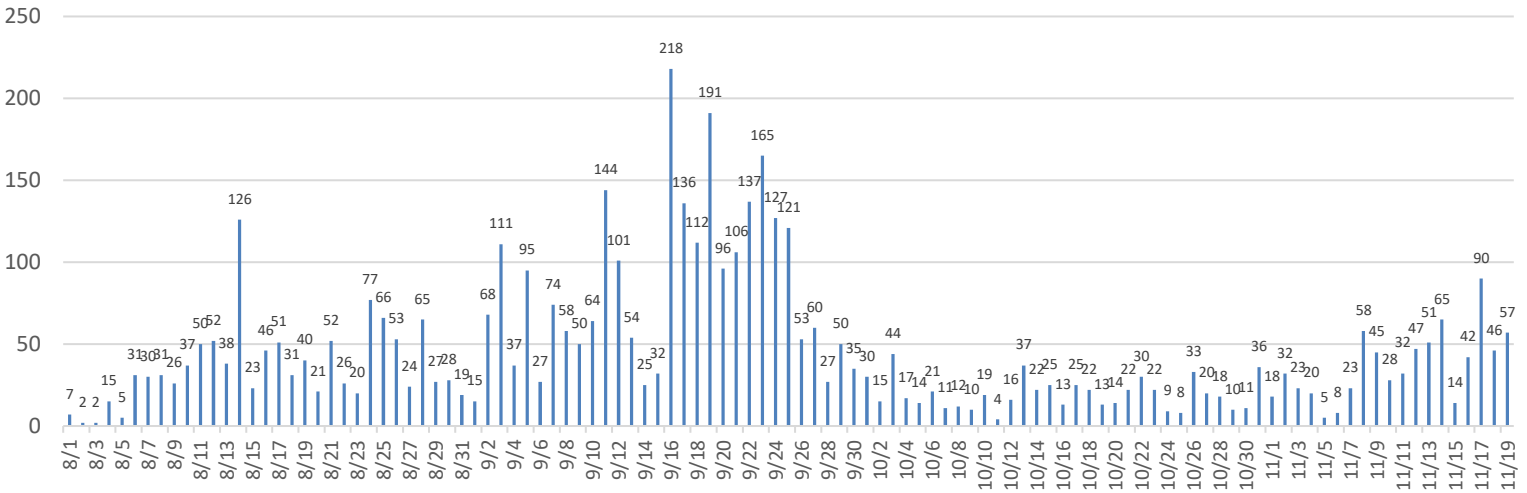
## COVID-19 LABORATORY STATUS AND DISEASE TREND OF BALOCHISTAN PROVINCE

Presently, (05) lab facilities are existing and functional in the whole province, COVID-19 testing report received form all. The graph 06 shows the daily basis lab testing number.

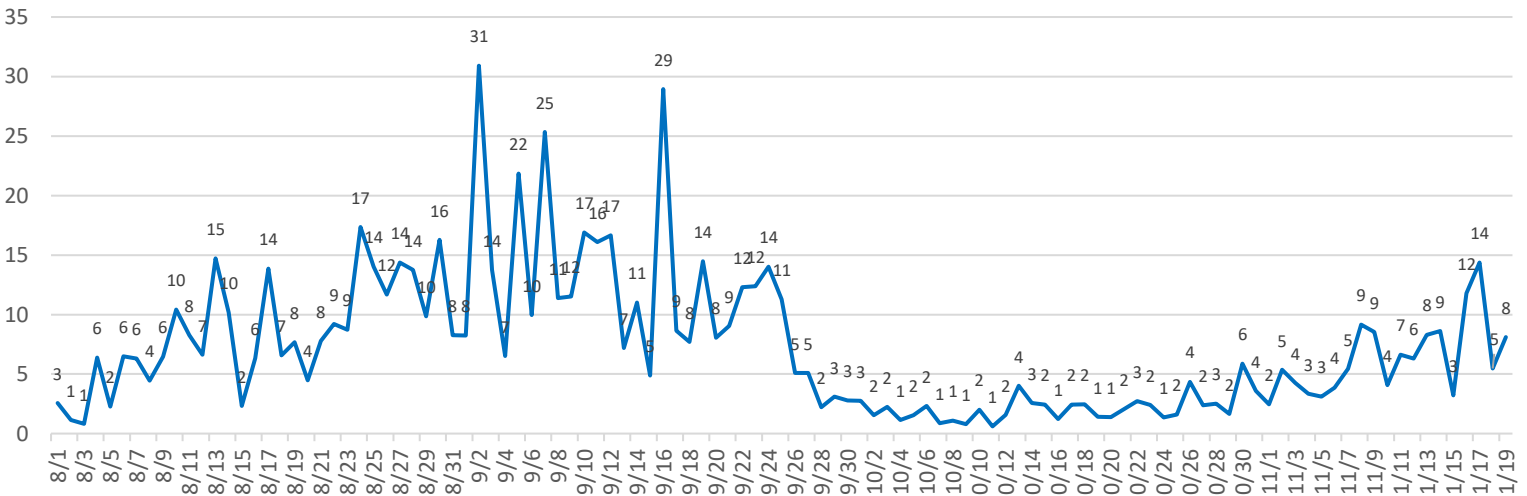
Graph 07. Daily Lab Test Conducted at Balochistan from 9 April - 19 Nov 2020 - Quetta (n=137,252 )



Graph 08. Daily wise COVID-19 Positive cases trend till 19 Nov 2020 , Balochistan

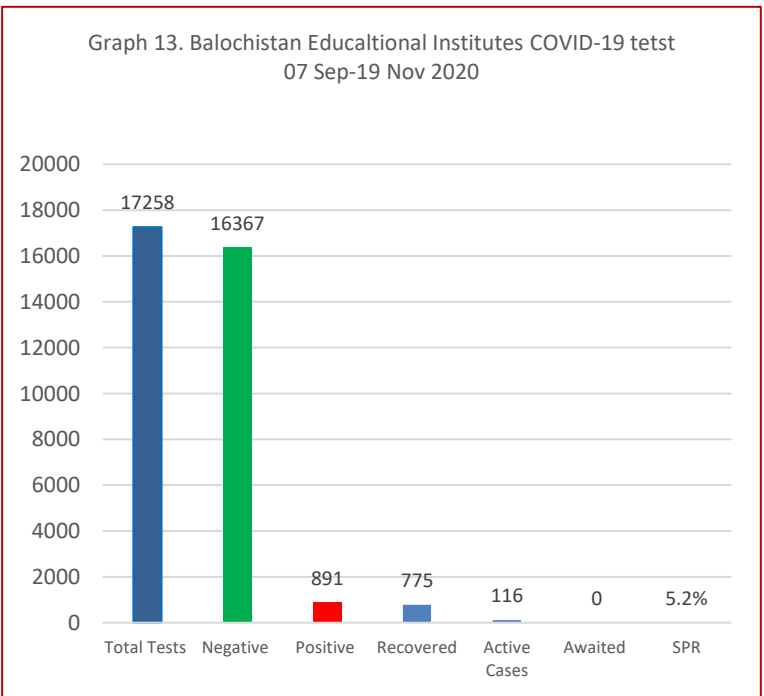
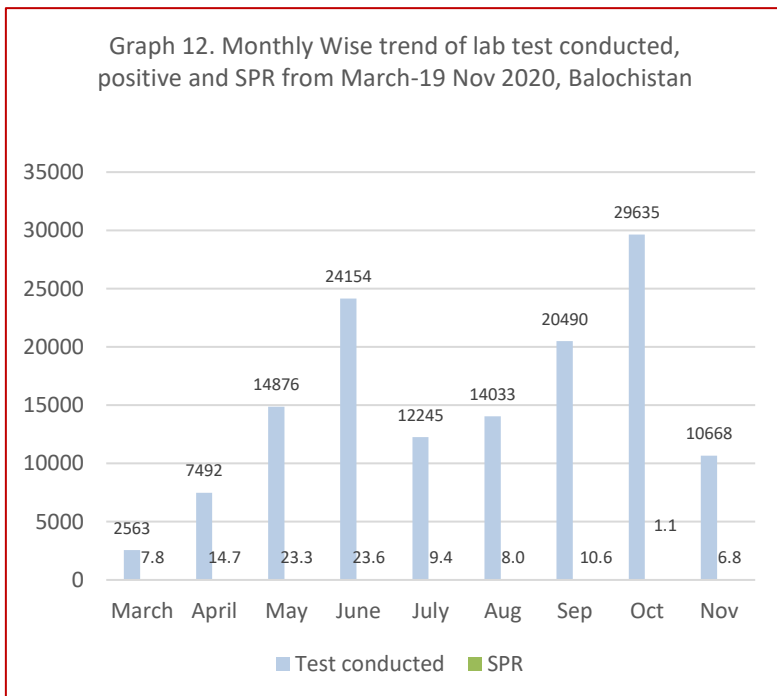
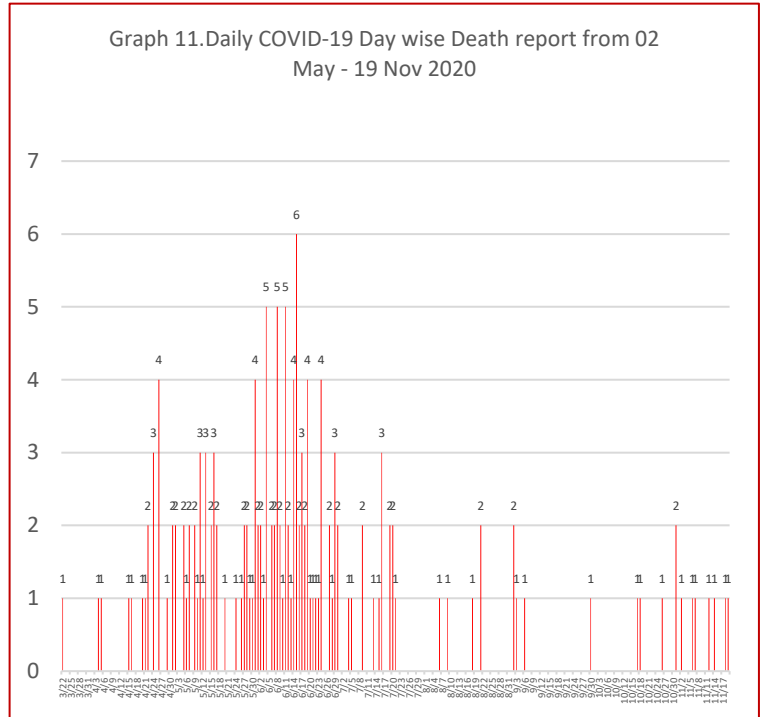
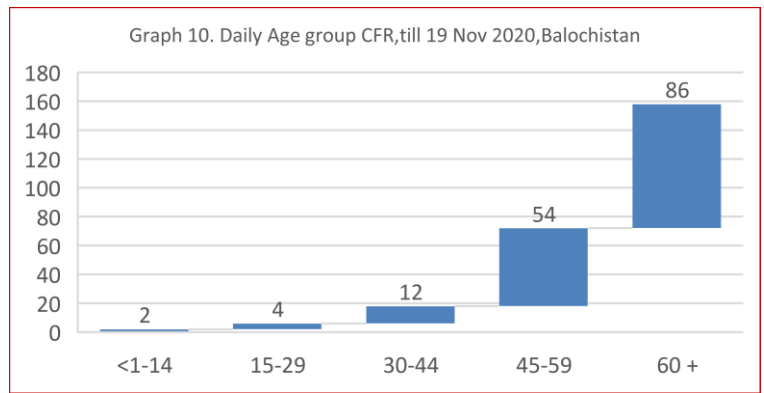


Graph 09. COVID-19 trend (SPR) from 01-Jun-19 Nov-2020, Balochistan Province

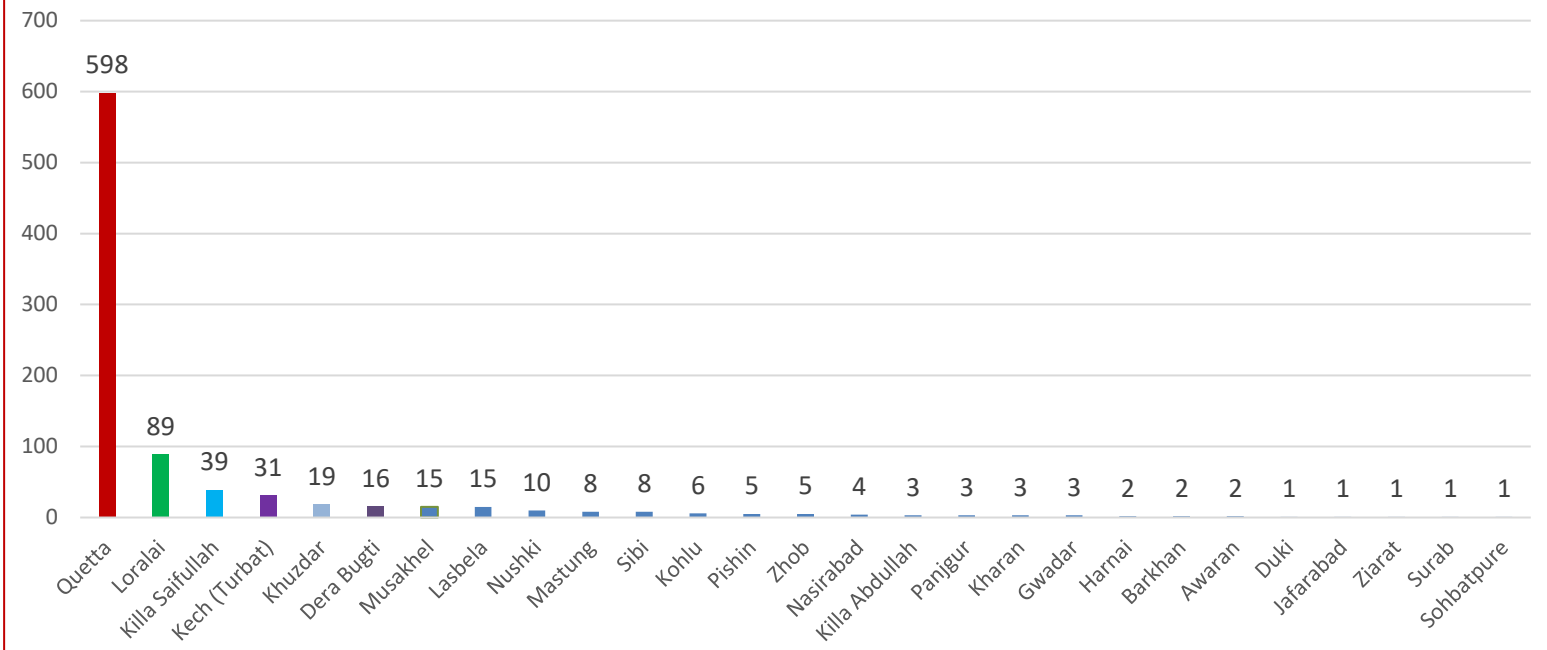
