

Government of Balochistan – Flood Relief Operations
PDMA Daily Press Release – 14th August 2022

Due to heavy rains in Qilla Abdullah, PDMA with assistance of Army / FC and DC responded immediately by rescuing over 1000 stranded people. Ten persons drowned out of whom six lost lives unfortunately taking the overall death toll to 188. Rupees one million compensation has already been paid to 90 families while 80 cases are in process with instructions of senior leadership to expedite these



cases; and, complete remaining 18, also. Here, in last 24 hours only; PDMA distributed 275 tents, 300 food packages, 500 blankets, 200 kitchen sets, 200 quilts, 200 hygiene kits, 4500 kgs flour, 20 first aid kits and 180 liters bottled water. Dewatering of area was also carried out. In addition, FC distributed 70 food packages and established a free medical camp to treat 45 patients.

Other than responding to emergencies created by yesterday's rainfall, PDMA distributed 7500 liters bottled water in Jhal Magsi. Relief Teams carried out dewatering in Chaman employing two pumps.

PDMA carried out rescue / relief operations in inundated areas of Marwar Sayedan, Bawan Peer Ali Zai and Killi Massay Zai which were affected due to damages to Machika Dam. Detail assessment / survey is in progress.



IRP (Islamic Relief Pakistan) provided 18 tents and 18 kitchen sets in Killi Qadirabad, Tehsil Noshki. International Qatar Charity Organization also distributed 300 food packages, here.

Muslim Hands Emergency Response (MHER) with assistance of Navy distributed 300 food packages in Jhal Magsi.

In Kech District, FC in last 24 hours distributed 110 food packages beside establishing five free medical camps to treat 61 patients in Proom, Mand, Mirani and Balnigore.



Rain impeded move of non-food items dispatched by NDMA on 12th August. Still, they managed to bring in 7944 items to Quetta and Uthal. The detail of which is 650 tents, 150 shelter tents, 250 school tents, 1000 tarpaulins, 1000 mosquito nets, 1000 sleeping bags, 1756 blankets, 400 hygiene kits, 1500 first aid kits, 20 generators, 20 dewatering pumps, 60 chemical spray machines and 138 kitchen sets.

Weather Alert suggests that monsoon currents will continue throughout the week i.e. until 19th August. It is likely to get harsher; heavy downpour may generate flash flooding in Qilla Saifullah, Loralai, Barkhan, Kohlu, Ziarat, Harnai, Musa Khel, Sherani, Sibbi, Bolan, Kalat, Quetta, Mastung, Surab, Kharan, Washuk, Chaghi, Khuzdar, Lasbela, Awaran, Turbat, Panjgur and coastal areas. PDMA has issued advisory to all concerned to remain alert and to take necessary precautionary measures.

PDMA in coordination with NDMA, Army / Navy / Air Force / FC and NGOs is making every possible effort to minimize sufferings of masses in flood affected areas.
