Media Reports

- **Rs120m for CM's fund for IDPs**

LAHORE: Cheques worth Rs120 million were donated for the Chief Minister's Relief Fund for the internally displaced persons (IDPs) on Sunday.

A handout said people were donating generously for the CM's fund.

It said people from all walks of life, especially philanthropists, industrialists, traders and parliamentarians donated for the fund that was a gesture of their trust in Shahbaz Sharif's leadership.

It quoted the CM as saying that those helping their brethren in the hour of need in the holy month of Ramazan were earning blessings of the Almighty.

The CM pledged judicious use of the donations for the IDPs.

NHN, Government and Non Government (Humanitarian Organizations) Interventions

For the development of joint monitoring mechanism for NWA- IDPs response the meeting was held in PDMA office today and following decisions were made:

- Keeping the security in high preference, Applications after approving from PDMA will be forwarded to 45 Div for security clearance
- All activities will be carried out in close coordination with PDMA
- Areas for implementing the project will be selected by DDMO Bannu /ACO
- 2 M&E officer from PDMA will monitor the activities in Bannu
- Role of M&E officer from PDMA will be facilitative rather than policing
- PDMA will ensure the proper utilization of funds/resources for IDPs by IPs/CPs
- Biweekly monitoring meetings of organizations will be carried out in Bannu and IDEA will provide the space for the meeting
- Joint Monitoring system /mechanism will be developed for monitoring and SOPs will be decided in the next meeting
- Organizations will invite PDMA's M&E officers on the day of any visible/ giant distribution in order to avoid any misconception
- Every organization will ensure transparency otherwise any dubious activity of any organization may lead to the cancelation of their NOC and many other option may be brought in use too
- Important contact numbers of PDMA staff will be shared with organizations for coordination
