Media Reports

- Government has failed to mobilize the public as was done during 2005 earthquake and 2010 epic Flood but this does not mean government lack resources.
- The team of PTIs women representatives will visit Bannu on Friday to oversee relief efforts being carried out at IDP camps.
- The rehabilitation and safe return of these people would be a big challenge for the government. Although FATA secretariat is already in the process of preparing a damage assessment report on the basis of which needs assessment in terms of rehabilitation and reconstruction would be carried out.

NHN, Government and Non Government (Humanitarian Organizations) Interventions

NHN had a meeting with Assistant commissioner Bannu, AD local Government, Assistant Director PDMA, Deputy Director PDMA and Revenue Department of Bannu. It has been decided in the meeting that NHN, PDMA, Local Government and AC Team Revenue department will conduct base line survey in 49 union

councils of Bannu. LG, Revenue department will provide human resource, and NHN will provide human resource in 49 Union councils of Bannu.

Assistant Commissioner will be the focal person for the activity and PDMA will monitor all the activities at field.
