According to latest hydrological conditions and due to breaching of bunds of River Chenab between Qadirabad and Punjnad, the risk of High to Very High Flood level at Guddu & Sukkur has decreased.

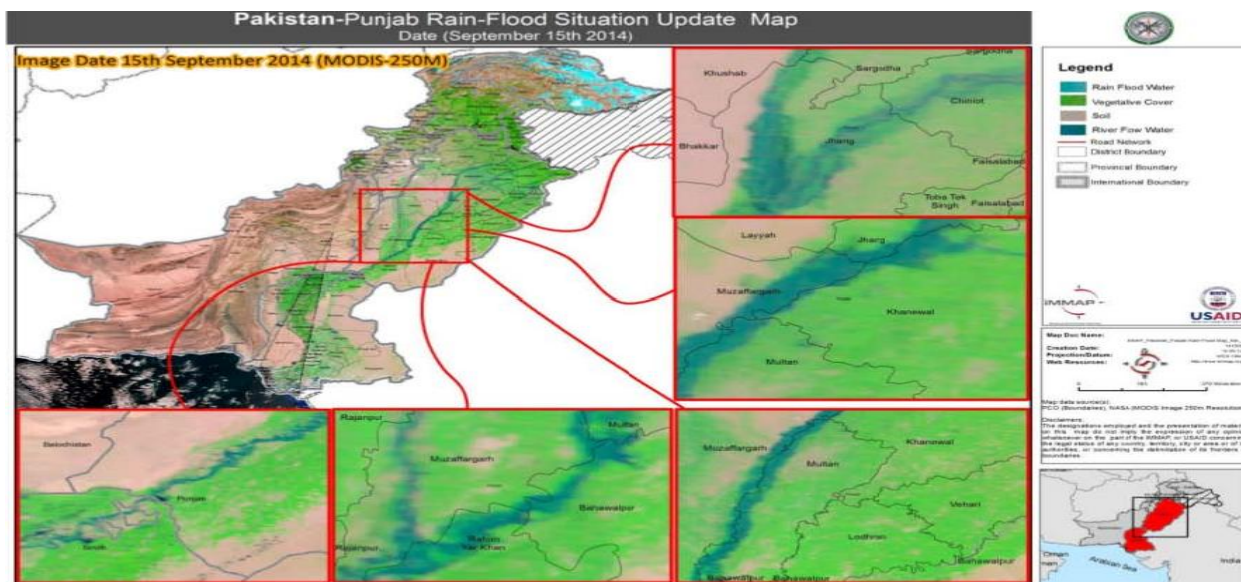
Therefore, the River Indus at Guddu & Sukkur may attain Medium to High Flood Level ranging between 4,00,000 Cusecs to 5,00,000 Cusecs from 16th September to 18th September -2014.

Sindh

Flood water is increasing in Sindh at Barrages, including Guddu barrage in Kashmore district. According to Pakistan Meteorology Department expected water flow is between 400, 0000-500,000 cusecs.

Expected time for water reaching at Sukkur Barrage is next 24-36 hours. Along with this, six revering districts including Kashmore, Ghotki, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Khairpur and Larkana have received flood alerts form PDMA of Sindh and strated evacuation of peoples living in Kacha areas.

Evacuation form Ghotki district has been reported from Union Council Bago Deho, Hussain Beli, Qadir Pur and Pakka Chandia.

Number of Evacuated Families

- ⇒ In Bago Deho 42 families have been evacuated
- ⇒ In Hussain Beli 120 families have been evacuated
- ⇒ In Qadir Pur 140 families have been evacuated
- ⇒ In Pakka Chandia 80 families have been evacuated

Damages Reported in AJKs

According to SDMA till 15 September 2014 damages recorded are as follow:

- **13** Hydro Power Stations in Neelum Valley were washed away by the flood
- **02** Spans of High Transmission Electricity Line at Lower Plate, Muzaffarabad fully destroyed.
- **1** Police Station, Lawat, Neelum partially damaged.
- **1** Pick-up got drowned into the river in Taali Mandi, Muzaffarabad
- **1** Police Check Post at Gari Habibullah partially damaged
- Road Linking Gari Habibullah with Muzaffarabad got cut off due to erosion
- **1** Bally Bridge was completely destroyed at Kalla lot, Neelum Valley
- **1** Bridge linking Sharda with Khari Gam was partially damaged in District Neelum
- **1** Foot Bridge at Surgan Nalla fully destroyed
- Pakistan Army's Commanding Officer's Office at Thejian fully destroyed
- Timber of AKLASC and Forest Department was also washed away in District Neelum

- Trees and crops/lands have also been reported to have got submerged into the water
- The livelihoods of the population living along Neelum River have severely got affected
- **110** Shops were fully destroyed due to flood in Nullah Mahal, District Bagh
- **02** Crush Machines were completely washed away in District Bagh
- **1** Poultry Shed was completely burnt by short circuit in District Rawalakot
- Machinery of Chinese Neelum Jhelum Hydro project has been partially damaged

Government, Non Government & NHN Interventions

Punjab:

NHN released a press release based on findings of flood affected population survey conducted by NHN Punjab (Annex)

Sindh:

⇒ Government has initiated evacuation camps preparation in advance, below are the list of evacuation centers:

- **07** camps in Ghotki
- **01** camp in Larkana
- **01** camp in Shikarpur
- **01** camp in Kandhkot
- **01** camp in Sukkur
- **02** camps in Kashmore
- **02** camps in Khairpur

⇒ PDMA Sindh has given two boats, 1000 tents and 1000 food baskets to each of the six revering districts

⇒ Government Finance department has released Rs. 20 million to each vulnerable districts for flood contingencies

AJK:

⇒ Rahman Welfare Trust (RWT) contacted NHN AJK for providing free medical camps in Hattian Bala, Muzaffarabad and Neelum districts starting from next week

⇒ Civil defense department is working through NHN volunteers from side to side emergency cell formed by the DG civil defense

⇒ PRCS District Branch Bagh has distributed Emergency Shelters and Non Food Items to 30 Flood affected Sanitary Workers Families in District Bagh

⇒ Around 102 families of affected areas were relocated to Jinnah Pilot High School Muzaffarabad, 51 families were relocated to their relatives residing at safer places

Humanitarian Needs

Sindh

- Government has to ensure rescue team on board to evacuate people on emergency bases
- First Aid and basic food items needs to be prepared along with evacuation points
- Access to safe drinking water needs to be facilitated in advance for emergency

Advocacy Issues Related to the Response

Sindh:

- ⇒ Irrigation departments needs to be more careful regarding breaches issues, so that past worst experiences cannot be replicated of saving urban areas and sacrificing the rural areas.
- ⇒ Schools building should not be used as an evacuation centers as they effect the education during floods
