**Hyderabad:** National Humanitarian Network (NHN) is closely analyzing current cyclone situation and its response strategies, in this regard, NHN Sindh shows great concern on the decision of Government authorities for the declaration of districts' schools as an evacuation centers.

Observing last four years of crises, Sindh has faced continuous effects of different disasters, which includes floods and drought. Apart from these disasters, management authorities have also contributed to worsen the situation by harming the education of Sindh by declaring the schools for evacuation centers.

It has been observed that evacuation to schools causes harms to education by closing the regular schools, using school furniture, engaging teachers in duties. All these worse situations can be managed well by prioritizing things in well manner.

Based on above discussed issues, NHN Sindh demands below mentioned actions from the provincial authorities:

- Schools should not be allocated for evacuation
- Tent cities need to be established for proper evacuation
- Teachers should not be involved in emergency crises so that education cannot be suffered
