Subject: **MORE MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED DURING THE WEEK**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed that monsoon currents from Arabian sea are likely to penetrate in upper and central parts of the country from 18th July (night) which are likely to intensify on 19th July. Under the influence of these weather systems:

- Rain/wind-thundershower (with heavy falls) is expected in Kas Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahaiddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Kasur, Mianwali, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar and Okara from 18th (night) to 23rd July with occasional gaps.
- Rain/wind-thundershower is also expected in D.G khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Bhakkar, Layyah, Kot Addu, Bahawalpur, Rahim Yar Khan from 19th (night) to 21st July with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy rain may cause urban flooding in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore from 18th (night) to 22nd July and may trigger landslides in the vulnerable areas of Murree during the period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Tourists are advised to remain extra cautious to avoid any untoward situation during the wet spell.
- Loose structures like electric poles, solar panels etc may damage during dust storm/wind-thunderstorm & heavy falls and general public is advised to stay at safe places during the period.
- General public is advised to stay at safe places during wind-storm/heavy rains

- مویشیوں کا انخلا اور چارے کی فراہمی / سرکنز چارے کی فراہمی مویشیوں کی ویکسینیشن کا انتظام پہلے سے ہونا چاہیے۔
- جن علاقوں کے زیر آب آنے کا زیادہ امکان ہے ان کے کمینوں کو جب بھی ضرورت ہو عارضی ریلیف کمپوں / محفوظ مقامات پر منتقل کیا جانا چاہیے۔
- وبائی امراض سے بچنے کے لیے طبی ٹیموں کو متاثرہ افراد کو ابتدائی طبی امداد کی فراہمی کے لیے متحرک کیا جائے
- بجلی کے جھٹکے سے بچنے کے لیے واپڈ احکام کے ساتھ ترجیحی بنیادوں پر ضروری انتظامات کیے جائیں۔
- سیلاب کے اثرات اور ریسکوی اور ریلیف آپریشنز کی مسلسل نگرانی کو یقینی بنایا جائے اور رسپانس کی حکمت عملی کو بہتر بنانے کے لیے خلا اور کامیابیوں کو دستاویزی شکل دی جائے۔
- DEOCs کو فیملڈ ٹیموں کے ساتھ اور ڈویژنل اور صوبائی حکام کے ساتھ رابطے کے لیے مضبوط کیا جائے گا، نیز نقصانات، بچاؤ اور امدادی کارروائیوں کے اعداد و شمار کو مضبوط کیا جائے گا تاکہ اعلیٰ دفاتر اور متعلقہ سپورٹ / امدادی ایجنسیوں سے مدد اور مشورے کے حصول کے لیے منصوبوں پر موثر عمل درآمد کیا جاسکے۔

2. All concerned authorities are advised to remain alert and also take all necessary precautionary measures during the forecasted period to avoid any loss of life/property.
3. The Concerned Deputy Commissioners are advised to keep operational / functional the District Emergency Operations Centers (DEOCs) round the clock during the above-mentioned period under intimation to PDMA, Punjab.
